What are must visit tourist attractions in the Andamans?

Some of the must visit locations in Andaman are-

**1. Cellular Jail National Memorial:** It's the former British prison that is now a shrine to the political dissidents it once jailed. Even though several parts of it have been destroyed by the Japanese during the World War II, it still stands tall reminding our brave and gallant forefathers.

**2. Mount Harriet and Madhuban:** Andaman offers best trekking experience for tourists. It's a gorgeous route where you can witness exotic flora and fauna of the land amidst spectacular sceneries. Elephant safari is also an option at Mount Harriet.

**3. Sea Walking at North Bay Beach:** North Bay Beach you can walk under the sea and finally visit 'Octopus's Garden'. It is easy swim here and explore the underneath world.

**4. Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park:** The park covers area of 280 sq km with 15 islands of mangrove creeks, tropical rainforests and reefs supporting 50 types of coral.

**5. Ross Island:** Once called as the 'Paris of the East' by the Brits. But all it's glory and tropical beauty was wrecked by the earthquake of 1941 and the Japanese invasion. It has English architecture and machine-gun nests that are great fun to poke finger in.

Where is Andaman and Nicobar Islands?

Andaman and Nicobar Islands are located in eastern part of Indian mainland isolated from the Bay of Bengal. Forming an archipelago in the Bay of Bengal, there are 600 islands and are also Union Territory of India. The territory <u>capital of</u> <u>Andaman is Port Blair</u> and capital of Nicobar Islands is Car Nicobar. It's a part of

India. Main islands in Andamans are- Land Fall Island, Middle Andaman, South Andaman, Port Blair and Little Andaman. Nicobar lies in the south. Both are separated by deep ten-degree channel.

How do I reach the Andaman and Nicobar Islands?

Andaman and Nicobar Islands are accessible by air and boat. There are regular flight from Chennai and Kolkata. The island can also be reached by waterways.

**By Air:** Veer Savarkar International Airport in Port Blair is connected to Kolkata and Chennai aiport. Air India, Spice Jet, Jet Konnect, Spice Jet and GoAir are available flight services.

**By Sea:** There are regular ship services leaving from Chennai, Kolkata and Vishakhapatnam to Port Blair. There are 2 ships- MV Nancowry and MV Swarajdweep - from Chennai and the MV Nicobar and MV Akbar from Kolkata. The journey takes 50-60 hours to reach its destination.

There are inter-connectivity options to reach different islands on Andaman. Directorate of Shipping Services, A & N Administration operates regular ferry services from Phoenix Bay Jetty, Port Blair in the inter-island and foreshore sectors connecting all populated island/tourist places.

Are the Andaman Islands safe?

As far as you follow the safety instruction during the water adventure and avoid visiting restricted areas. The crime rate is extremely low. So one can have a safe tour around Andaman and Nicobar Islands. If you're looking forward to water adventure, then find out the safe swimming zone and make sure the lifeguard is around. Seek advice from lifeguard before getting into the adventure. There are few incidents where tourists were attacked by water animals. So need to be careful. Human attack cases are very few due to regular police patrolling.

The general climate of Andaman Islands is pleasant. However, the best season considered is October to April when monsoon isn't forecasted and climate remains pleasant. Being surrounded by sea, the cool breeze helps to keep the temperature to range in between 23° C and 31° C. Monsoon brought by the southwest wind sets in during mid-May and continues till early October. Season for nature lovers is May to December when forest is lush green and waterfalls are at their prime. Divers can enjoy the best during December to April and bird watchers during winter times.

Are rains frequent in the Andamans and Nicobar Islands?

No, rains appear from May end and continuous till September or even October. However, the climatic condition cannot be trusted and it can rain anytime.

What are the different activities one can do the Andamans?

What currency is used in the Andaman Islands?

Indian rupees is used in Andaman Islands.

What is RAP (Restricted Area Permit)?

The Restricted Area Permit (RAP) is important acquire for foreigners to visit certain restricted areas in India. There are certain areas in India which can act dangerous to foreign tourists. These areas can be located in remote places and away from normal tourist destinations. Previously, RAP were lifted from Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Darjeeling. NRIs will have to apply for regular RAP in every visit to such areas.

In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, there few restricted locations to visit which tourists' needs to have RAP. The permit granting authorities are: MHA & FRROS All Indian Missions Abroad Chief Immigration Officer, Chennai Immigration Officer, Port Blair

Is there any RAP (Restricted Area Permit) required for visiting the Andaman Islands?

Yes, there are certain locations in Andaman Islands which requires tourist to have RAP. To get RAP for Andaman Islands, one must visit to Port Blair and is issued for free of cost to foreign travellers. There are restricted areas in Andaman, especially in the tribal areas where no-entry zone is banded. The RAP is easily available on arrival at Port Blair by flight or ship from the Immigration Authorities for 30 days subject to availability of valid visa. The permit is accessible for 15 days. It can also be obtained from Indian Missions overseas and also from the foreigners Registration offices at New Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata and from the Immigration Authorities at the Airports of New Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata.

SOS Kiosk (Emergency Assistance Booth) has been setup at Rajeev Gandhi water sports complex, Port Blair and other places. Make sure you wear life jacket before boarding the boat.

Is there any age limit for the water activities in Andaman?

For water activities, the age limit is 7-60 years. It also depends on the activities undertaken. Moreover, it depends on the medical restriction for the activity. Also if you've water phobia or any other health problem, it is important to avoid water activities in Andaman. To know about the age limit, you can talk to the lifeguards before venturing into the water.

Is it worth visiting the Andamans for Scuba Diving?

Scuba diving in the Andaman Islands is the major activity, where you can explore the world beneath the blue sea. One can enjoy hours of scuba diving activity to explore marine life and get close to them. There are different Scuba Diving services for swimmers and non-swimmers. For this, there are no swimming skills required. Also one can record personal videos at the end of the dive. Also, swimmers will be provided with a certificate.

One can also opt for Scuba Diving for Certified Divers 2 days 4 dives Scuba Diving in Andaman with Barefoot Scuba- 40 minutes Night Diving for Certified Divers Scuba Diving in Neil Island- 60 minutes for beginners.

What kind of shopping can be done on the Andaman and Nicobar Islands?

There are various beach markets and quaint outlets to shop in Andaman. From cane handicrafts to wooden decorative items, one can shop for different option. Visit Port Blair market for interior decoration shopping. With the rise in tourism, the shopping options have also increased. You can take help of tour operators or locals to know which islands must be visited and which shouldn't be.

How many islands in Andaman are open to tourists?

There are 550 islands in Andaman and Nicobar, and most of these are in Andaman. 26 of which are inhabited. So you can visit some of the most visited islands including Havelock Island, Neil Island, Baratan Island, Little Andaman, Long Island, etc.

What is the culture of Andamans?

There is a mix culture in Andaman. Both Indians and Natives reside here making it unique. However, Andamanese, Jarawa, Jangil, Onge and Sentinelese are major groups. Hindi, Tamilian, Malayalam, Telugu and Bengali culture are too followed here. These communities follow their religion thoroughly and celebrate festivals like others. The original native group in the Andamans is the Onges, who live in Little Andaman. Onges, like other Andamanese tribes, are of Negrito origin.

Are there any religious restrictions on the Andaman Islands?

There is no religious restrictions here as mixed culture people reside in this island. However, one needs to be careful to avoid any kind of communal issues. There has been no issues till date.

How can I travel from Port Blair to Havelock and ? Should I return the same day?

To reach Havelock Island from Port Blair, it will take 3 hrs 12min. There are regular government and private ferry service.

You can spend some days at Havelock Island to explore some exotic beaches and locations around. This also allows you to take rest and experience the place.

Is Cellular Jail open on all the days?

No! Cellular Jail can be visited between 9 Am to 1 Pm and 2 Pm to 5 Pm. One can explore the entire area of Cellular Jail. The entrance block of the National

Memorial houses, Freedom Fighters Photo and Exhibition Gallery in the Ground Floor. The first floor of the building has an Art Gallery, Netaji Gallery and a Library on Freedom Movement. Gallery on First War of Independence and on Old Photographs Gallery have also been set up in the premises of the National Memorial.

Are there any endangered tribes in the Andamans?

Jarawas, Sentinelese, Onge and Great Andamanese are tribes in Andaman. These Negrito tribes arrived from Africa 60, 000 years ago.

**Jarawas:** This indigenous group live in Andamand Islands and parts of South Andaman and Middle Andaman Islands, and their present numbers are estimated at between 250–400 individuals. They no more interact with outsiders, and many particulars of their society, culture, and traditions are poorly understood.

**Bo People:** This indigenous tribe spoke a distinctive Bo language, closely related to the other Great Andamanese languages. There are still few who identify themselves as members of the tribe living on a reservation on Strait Island.

**Onge:** This Andamanese people are traditionally hunter-gatherers, they are a designated Scheduled Tribe of India.

**Sentinelese:** This indigenous group resist contact with the outside world, and are among the last people to remain virtually untouched and uncontacted by modern civilization.

Can I meet the endangered tribes on the Island?

These endangered tribes stay away from tourists and meeting them could be a cause of entering into their zone. It is better to stay away from these endangered group because it can be dangerious for you too. Better to enjoy the scenic beauty and culture of the island rather entering into the endangered zone of inside world.

Is it permissible to photograph the indigenous tribal people on the Island?

Indigenous tribal people don't involve with outside world and clicking pictures of them could be risky. So it is not permissible to click pictures of them. It is not allowed to enter into their zone and clicking their pictures.

What are some specialities about the flora and fauna of the Andamans?

Andaman is the home of some richest flora and fauna. There are 2000 plus species in this island. Also there are 240 species of birds found here. This include- Andaman wood pigeon, Andaman scop's owl, the blue-eared kingfisher and the fulvous breasted woodpecker. There are two species of wild boars, feral elephants, four species of sea turtles and wild salt water crocodiles make the islands a wildlife hotspot.

When it comes to flora and fauna, it can't be complete to mention Marine Life. With crystal clear blue water and exotic corals are the biggest crowd pullrs. One can also enjoy interesting variety of seashells and have become part of the island's lifeline. Andaman is blessed with sheer variety and diversity of lifeforms and ecosystems in the island is what draws nature lovers,

What Beaches should one must visit in the Andamans?

Beaches in Andaman are worth exploring because of their exotic look. The waters display some amazing shades of emerald green. The corals and marine life offer a beautiful underwater adventure. There are some amazing beaches in Andaman which includes-

**Elephant Beach-** It is known for unspoilt beauty. It is a must visit if you are going to Havelock, especially since it takes on 20 minutes from the dock.

**Guitar Island and Beach-** It looks great from the Ariel view. This exotic island is tucked out of common tourist itineraries and is among the least visited islands.

Red Skin Island Beach- This isn't your typical Andaman beach with a huge

stretch of sand and blue waters. It is more like mangrove extension with a very narrow beach strip.

**Chidiyatapu Beach-** The beach is located in the southernmost tip of south Andaman about 30km from Port Blair. Called as Nightfall Point or Flying Creature Island, one can enjoy the best sunset in the Andaman.

**Badabalu Beach-** Tucked away from tourist location, Badabalu looks a different from the traditional Andaman beaches. The sand is greyish brown and the water is a cool shade of blue.

Little Andaman Beach- One of the most visited beaches, this is the fourth largest of Andaman Islands. You can go for boat rides between the creeks, coral viewing.

**Radhanagar Beach-** It is known for turquoise blue waters and white sandy shores. Radhanagar beach was named as Asia's best beach and the world's seventh best beach by Time magazine.

What should be the mode of travel during the visit to the Andamans?

Ships, boat and ferry are main mode of travel in Andamans. One can also use local transport to explore Andamans.

How good is the cruise services on the Andamans?

The cruise service in Andaman depends on the company that offers the service. Private cruise services are equipped with better amenities and good hospitality, though they are pricy. Cruise is the best travel option in Andaman that allows the tourist to travel around. The cruises take almost 90 minutes to reach Havelock Island from Port Blair and vice versa. From Neil(another island in Andaman archipelago), the cruises take around 60 Minutes to reach Havelock Island.

These cruises are divided into 3 different classes such as Premium, Deluxe and Royal. There are also some private charters offering luxury services inside.

What kind of medical facilities are available on the Andamans?

There are some good medical facilities in Andaman. GB Pant Hospital, INHS Dhanvantari, Chakraborty Hospital, Pillar Health Center, ACE Hospital and few others.

Is there any money exchanging facility available on the Andaman Islands?

You can exchange currency in airport, banks and currency dealers in Andaman. This money exchange facility is offered for oversease tourists. You can get your money exchanged at the Port Blair airport and banks in Havelock and the capital city.

Cards work in Port Blair and Havelock Island restaurants and hotels. In remote area, there will be a network issue, so carry enough cash.

What are the essential items that one must pack while travelling to the Andamans?

When you're<u>travelling to Andaman</u>, apart from required documents, you need to carry right items according to the weather the region has. Light cotton clothes, sunglasses, vital medicines and sunburn relief products. Along with these, do carry passport, spare passport photos and ID proof.Apart from this, please make sure that you've proper reservation in hotels.
