Another way to reach Dubai is land at Sharjah International Airport and then take a taxi or bus and travel by road to reach Dubai. One can also take the Emirates Express bus which connects Abu Dhabi and Dubai.

What is the best time to visit Dubai?

Summer Season (June - August) - The summer season is known for temperatures hitting 50 degrees Celsius with scorching heat and humidity in the air. Shoulder Season (April - May, Sept - October) - This is the shoulder season between summers and winters in Dubai. Although it is hot in Dubai, the temperature ranges around 28 degrees Celsius which makes it an ideal time to enjoy swimming and other beach activities. It's also a great time for budget vacationers who can enjoy good deals and discounts on hotels this time.

Peak Season (November - March) - This is one of the best times to visit Dubai as the temperature hovers between 17 degrees to 30 degree Celsius. This is a splendid time to explore the beaches and spend your time in numerous outdoor activities. However, it's the peak season in Dubai with everyone flocking to this city at its best, one may find difficulty in booking hotels for their vacation.

What are the best ways to travel in and around Dubai?

What currency is used in Dubai?

The currency used in Dubai is the UAE Dirham which is represented as Dhs or AED. US \$ 1 is equal to 3.675 Dhs. The notes in Dirhams are of different values like 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1000. The 200 note and the 1000 note look similar so that be very careful while you use them. The notes of Dhs 100 can be taken while you travel around and explore and some lower values as well if you would like to do shopping. The coins available are the silver Dhs 1. 50 fils and 25 fils.

Also, major international credit and debit cards can also be used in large shops and hotels. You can make use of the bank services which will be available on all working days from Saturday to Thursday from 08:00 am to 01:00 pm. There are a lot of currency exchange centres placed in malls and souks.

Is a visa required for Dubai?

Yes, you need a visa to visit Dubai. Apart from the citizens of Andorra, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Hong Kong, Ireland, Japan, Malaysia, Monaco, New Zealand, People's Republic of China, Russian Federation, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, United Kingdom, United States of America, Vatican City, other countries' citizens require a visa to visit UAE. In total, citizens from 48 countries apart from GCC nations can get a Visa on arrival and it cannot be renewed after 90 days of your stay.

Getting a Visa is depending on several factors like the nationality, the purpose of your visit and the duration of your stay. To get a pre-arranged visa, you can apply through online on Emirates.com. If you have a relative or family member living in UAE, they can apply for visas on your behalf and but it is mandatory that they should be the residents of the UAE.

How long does it take to get a visa to Dubai? How much does it cost for a tourist visa to Dubai?

Based on the type of visa you are applying for, the duration to get it processed will be varying. Normal Visa will take around 3 to 4 working days to reach you

while Express Visa will be processed in 1 to 2 working days but there is an extra charge than Normal Visa to be paid. You will get the Urgent Visa in 24 hours but it has comparatively more charges than the other two visas.

The cost of a tourist visa to Dubai from India depends on the agency you will be applying through. The basic prices currently the agencies are following are as given below: Tourist Visa starting from INR 5290 Express Tourist Visa starting from INR 7440

Is there visa on arrival in Dubai?

The nationals of the following countries will get a visa on arrival in Dubai. Andorra, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Hong Kong, Ireland, Japan, Malaysia, Monaco, New Zealand, People's Republic of China, Russian Federation, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, United Kingdom, United States of America, Vatican City are the major countries which do not need a pre-arranged vis to come to Dubai. In total, citizens from 48 countries apart from GCC nations can get a Visa on arrival and it cannot be renewed after 90 days of your stay.

Do you need a visa for connecting flights in UAE?

If your connecting flight is within 8 hours from your arrival at the airport, you need not have a visa but if the flight takes more than 8 hours, the authorities may ask you for a UAE visa. There are around 48 countries which would not need a pre-arranged visa. The nationals from these countries can get a visa on arrival at the airport.

Do you need a visa to transit through Abu Dhabi?

If you are staying at the international airport in less than four hours, then you will not need a transit visa. However, if the time is extended, you have to check with your airlines to get a transit visa if you are travelling through Abu Dhabi. Nationals from 48 countries declared by the UAE government would get a visa on arrival at the airport. But others would need a transit visa if you are spending more than the prescribed duration at the airport.

Depending on the season, the temperature level in Dubai varies. During summer season, the day temperature may go up to 45-47* Celsius and evening temperature around 30* Celsius. During winter, the average high temperature is 30-32* Celsius and low temperature is at an average of 20-22* Celsius.
