Most countries do not have to obtain a visa either. If you are traveling from India, there are many direct flights from the Delhi International Airport to Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport in Port Louis.

You will be required to show proof of your return tickets, eligibility to re-enter their country of origin and enough finances for your period of stay over there. However, if you plan on staying for longer than 60 days for any such reason, you must apply for a visa at the Mauritius High Commission in Delhi prior to your visit.

What is the currency of Mauritius and where can I get my money exchanged?

The currency used in Mauritius is called the Mauritian Rupee and the currency code is MUR. The exchange rate from USD to MUR is 1 USD = 39.85 MUR and from Indian currency is 1 INR = 0.53 MUR. The best place to exchange your currency would be upon arrival at the airport as they have the best exchange rates.

However, you could also get your currency exchange at foreign exchange booths or ATM's found everywhere on the island, these have a better exchange rate than hotels and banks. Although some places do accept foreign currency, locals always prefer to be paid in the local rupee and keep in mind that in case you pay with a foreign currency, your change will always be returned in the local currency and you might lose a little money that way.

It's open on all days and the operating hours are from 08:30 am to 04:30 pm. The minimum age limit for the submarine would be a minor of 3 years accompanied by someone.
