
Weather

Kenya experiences only two kinds of weather throughout the year that is a wet season and a dry season. The best time to visit Kenya would be:

June to October: during this dry season it is easier to spot more animals while safaris. Trekking and camping are safer and easier. The sunny weather and high temperature ensure that there are no mosquitoes. This is the ideal season to witness the annual wildebeest migration.

November to May: during the wet season, Kenya experiences continuous rainfall. The flora is at its peak and the whole place looks beautiful. However, some of the resorts and lodges shut down in these seasons.

How to reach Kenya?

Kenya is a well-connected state and is very accessible. One can use a number of ways to reach Kenya.

By Plane: It has four international airports in Nairobi, Mombasa, Kisumu, and Eldoret. A large number of flights fly in and fly out from these airports making it very easy to reach Kenya by plane.

By Car: Being a great tourist attraction, Kenya has well-built roads which are connected to the neighbouring countries quite efficiently. So one can easily drive up through the wide highway network and reach Kenya in just a few hours.

Do I need a visa for Kenya? How does one get a Kenya visa?

Only a select number of nationalities require a visa in order to visit Kenya. In order to enter Kenya one needs to have a valid passport and a visa if required. The visa can be purchased on the international airports while entering Kenya. However, a visa obtained in advance ensures that they won't be any complications. One can get the visa online or from the embassy just like any other visa. The cost of the visa is quite minimal and the validity can be different

The currency commonly used in Kenya is a Kenyan Shilling that comprises of 100 cents and comes in various denominations. Since the exchange rate in respect to a US dollar and a British Pound is relatively low, the Ksh doesn't cost much. One can get the currency converted at the international airports itself. Besides that, there are a number of banks in Kenya that make the exchange right away with minimal formalities. One can even use their foreign credit and debit cards if they do not want to carry currency notes.

The cost of the safari varies according to the duration of the safari. A one-day safari in the National park costs about \$250 per person and costs less if the tickets are booked for larger groups. The longer safaris say about 5-day long cost around \$1200- \$500 per person and includes an array of activities like night drive, bush walk and so on. In Indian currency, the wildlife safari costs about Rs. 10,000 – Rs. 50,000 depending on the duration.
